Soybean recommendations

Roundup XtendFlex Soybeans-

4121RXF/SR Fullseason or Doublecrop

Broad acre placement variety. SR with strong tolerance to high pH soils. Medium tall plant with good standability. Unique creamy tan color at harvest.

4320RXF Fullseason

Bushy plant type with strong yield performance. Watch standability in high yield environments. Strong on high pH.

4720RXF/SR Fullseason or Doublecrop

Excellent yield potential with good standability. Good emergence in the Spring.

We have a double crop soybean discount program available on STS soybeans. Also, milo varieties are available for double cropping behind wheat.

With our seed treater, we can customize seed treatments. We strongly recommend fungicide and insecticide on soybeans for disease control.

We have upgraded our treater with a new applicator for a new product from **Acceleron – E-007 SAT** (Dry Seed Finisher) that improves seed planting and handling performance, which is definitely a seed flow improvement!

Just a reminder – Seed that is treated with Acceleron's full seed treatment (fungicide & insecticide) is covered by 100% replant policy. With seed treatment, data shows that replants are 75% less likely. We have seen a 5-15% increase in final stand where seed was treated.

Wheat has developed slowly throughout much of Kansas this Spring, due to lack of moisture and cool weather. Wheat mites, mostly winter grain and brown wheat mites, have affected much of the wheat throughout the central part of the state. Hopefully, we get adequate moisture plus the transition to the mite's non-feeding stage will help these areas recover.

Wheat Streak Mosaic has also been affecting the wheat in areas. The virus that causes it survives in volunteer wheat and is spread by wheat curl mites. Plants infected with wheat streak mosaic are also commonly infected with **High Plains Disease** and **Triticum Mosaic**. The symptoms of these diseases are nearly identical.

Management: Control volunteer wheat, delayed planting date, and planting varieties with genetic resistance.
